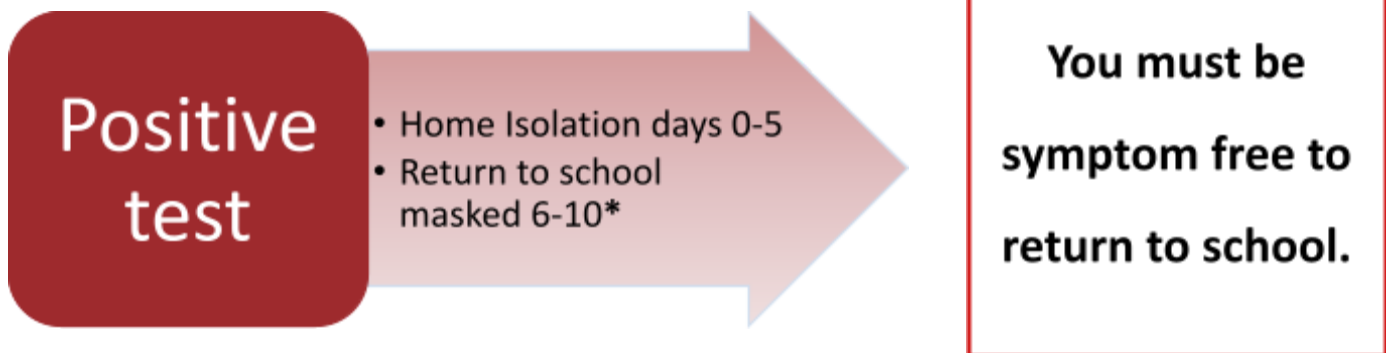


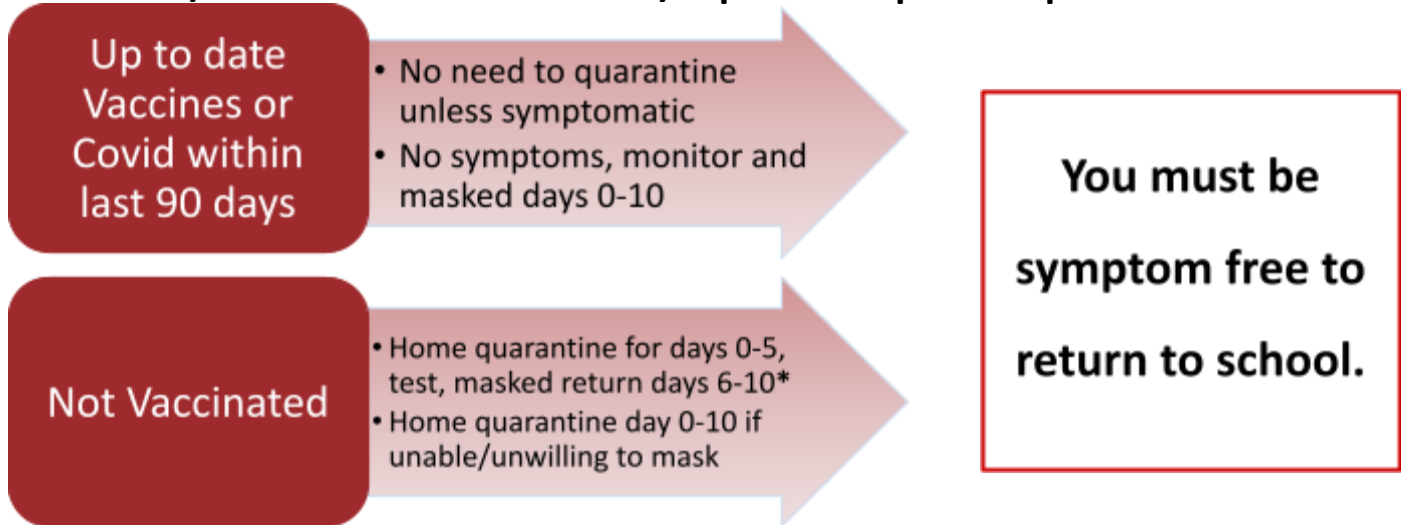

Muskegon Public Schools will continue to operate under universal masking. MPS continues to urge students and staff, **if you do not feel well do not come to school.** We are aligning our isolation/quarantine plan with the recommendations from Michigan Department of Health and Human Services (MDHHS) and the Center for Disease Controls (CDC) new K-12 school recommended COVID guidelines. Day "0" is the day of last close contact or the date of positive test.

If the staff/student tests positive:



If the staff/student are Close Contact/Exposed⁺ to positive person:



* Masking is required 100% of the time indoors. Eating/drinking must be done separately at a safe distance. Any activity requiring removal of a mask (Band, PE, mask breaks, etc.) must not be done until after this time period.

+ Close contact includes a positive case in the household or contact within 6' without mask
